



Declaration of Conformity to Restriction of Hazardous Substances (RoHS)

We recognise the importance eliminating hazardous substances from products and enabling safer recycling and more responsible end-of-life management of electronic equipment to support Environmental, Social, and Governance (ESG) principles.

UK / EU RoHS (Directive (EU) 2015/863)

Based on information provided by our component suppliers CoolLED confirms that all products manufactured and supplied conform with the requirements of Directive 2011/65/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council on the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment (RoHS), as amended by Directive (EU) 2015/863 (commonly referred to as “RoHS 3” or “RoHS III”).

Our products do not intentionally contain the restricted substances above the maximum concentration values specified in Annex II of Directive 2011/65/EU (as amended).

China RoHS II

China RoHS II was issued on 6 January 2016 and formally implemented on 1 July 2016. Based on information obtained from our component suppliers, CoolLED confirms that all products manufactured and supplied by CoolLED Ltd comply with the requirements of SJ/T 11364-2014 – Marking for the restriction of hazardous substances in electrical and electronic products and GB/T 26572-2011 – Requirements for concentration limits of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic products
