

WEEE Regulations Compliance Statement

CoolLED is a growing and ambitious company committed to sustainable business practices, including the responsible management of end-of-life CoolLED Illumination Systems. The European Union Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment (WEEE) Regulations 2013, as implemented in the UK from 1 January 2014, place obligations on CoolLED as a producer of certain electrical and electronic equipment (EEE). Our WEEE Producer Registration Number is [WEE/GB4236XX].

This statement explains how we meet our obligations under the WEEE Regulations.

WEEE Marking

All qualifying products subject to the WEEE Directive and supplied by CoolLED comply with the applicable WEEE marking requirements.

Products are marked with the “crossed-out wheeled bin” symbol in accordance with EN 50419, indicating that they are covered by the WEEE Regulations and must not be disposed of as unsorted municipal (household) waste.

Information for Users

The WEEE symbol on the product or its packaging means that the product:

- Must not be disposed of with general municipal or household waste
- Must be separated and sent to an appropriate collection, treatment and recycling facility for waste electrical and electronic equipment

Correct segregation and recycling of EEE at end-of-life helps to conserve natural resources, recover valuable materials and protect the environment.
